R3-Reviewed break #3 pops up at the start, then #2 does step over into the gap. #1 off slow

R4- #1 breaks inward almost losing rider, #5 has traffic troubles around first turn before getting room in the stretch.#1 tries to push out in the stretch with the #8 holding her in, they rub together no violations.

R5-Stewards Inquiry and JCOF # 6 Pinto (3rd) on #5 Crawford (2nd) and #7 Cheyne (4th) before the first turn. #6 takes back as the room between the #5 and #7 tightens. #5 is getting pressure from the inside #4 Buchanan (5th) moves out. #6 Pinto felt that the #5 came over deliberately. #5 Crawford felt he was being pressured from the inside. #7 Cheyne felt he was trying to stay out as much as possible. After review of the films. It was determined that the pressure came from the inside #4 and no placings were necessary.
