Backstretch:

A review was held last week regarding a report that was provided by Racing Forensics. The report dated July 6, 2026, detailed that the horse, American of Course, which finished first in the 4th race, attended the test barn for testing but failed to remain to provide urine, the attendants left the enclosure prior to the sample being collected. It was determined by the Stewards that there was no intent to manipulate an abandoned test and are satisfied that this incident was a mis-communication issue and no further action to be taken. All monies previously held have been released.

Race 1, #2 No Visor, S. Jadoo, 5th, stumbled badly at the start, #4 Brazilian Legacy, D. Gaskin, 4th, awkward start, rest ok

Race 2, #1 Mi Tormenta, S. Jadoo, 4th, off a step slow, rest good

Race 3, #2 Arctic Velocity, C. Jordan, 4th, bore out and stumbled slightly, #5 Likeitwhenitsnows, S. Jadoo, 5th, turned its head prior to the start was straightened out by the handler and was slow, received a fair start, rest ok

Race 4, all clear, reviewed run down the backstretch as it was visible that the blinkers on #4, Cantucci, A. Sanchez, 2nd, do come loose and subsequently removed by the jockey Alexis Sanchez, reviewed a few times to see if there was any actions prior to the start that would have compromised the equipment, we also spoke with Jockey Sanchez to ask if anything occurred prior to the race that would have lead to the blinkers coming loose, he stated that there was issues warming up or in the gate, as they came loose he was able to pull them straight back and hold onto them.

Race 5, All clear

Race 6, #6 Getting Ahead, B. Cheyne, reared when attempting to load into the gate and unseated B. Cheyne and then fell over to its side, was scratched by the Official Veterinarian, refund of \$14,004, Race all clear, back tower camera angle was not available, spoke with broadcast, did not record. Will monitor

Race 7, #2 Bingo's Grind, K. Johnson, 5th, head high at the start, off slow, rest ok

Race 8, Turf, Dead Heat for place between #1 Kid Gizmo and #5 Really Thirsty, rest ok.
