COVID-19 Prevention Guide

The health and safety of our employees is always a priority at Fort Erie Race Track, and we want to continue to keep our staff safe as we resume our racing operation. All employees are asked to read this COVID-19 guide for important health and safety information.

What is COVID -19 and how is it spread?

COVID-19 is a new respiratory illness, that causes flu-like symptoms and severe illness. COVID-19 can travel in respiratory droplets from an infected person that are released into the environment by laughing, coughing or sneezing. It can also be spread through close personal contact, such as shaking hands, or touching something with the virus, then touching your nose, mouth or eyes before washing your hands.

Signs and Symptoms

Symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to the flu, such as cough, fever, and difficulty breathing. It can take up to 14 days for someone to show symptoms after being exposed, and some people may not show symptoms at all. During this time, the virus can be spread from someone who may not know they are infected, which is why physical distancing is important.

What should I do If I'm feeling ill?

If you or a member of your family begin to feel ill, complete the online self-assessment tool, call your primary care provider (ex: family physician), or call Telehealth: 1-866-797-0000. Contact your supervisor so that necessary precautions can be taken.

If you begin to feel ill while at work, separate yourself from others and notify your supervisor immediately.

How to wash a fabric face mask:

1. It is recommended that washable face masks be cleaned using laundry detergent in a washing machine on the hottest possible setting.
2. If you do not have a washing machine, clean your mask thoroughly by hand using laundry detergent, then soak your mask in boiling water for five minutes. Everything should be sanitized afterwards (your hands, sink, and whatever you soak the mask in).
3. Masks can be dried in a dryer, but should be air dried if they have elastic bands.
4. Once dry, store masks in a clean, sealable plastic bag until you are ready to wear again.

What are we doing to keep our staff and horsepeople safe?

Fort Erie Race Track will be following Ontario Public Health guidelines for the safety of our staff and horsepeople, and stop the spread of COVID-19. We have implemented new safety procedures and restrictions. Below are some of the steps we have taken:

- We are providing all staff with non-medical masks and gloves to be worn while at Fort Erie Race Track.
- We have installed more hand washing stations and hand sanitizer stations.
- We have increased the cleaning frequency of our facility, especially high-touch surfaces such as door knobs.
- We are enforcing physical distancing, and are limiting the number of people permitted in small spaces.
- We are requiring that all staff and horsepeople go through daily screening when they arrive at our venue. Anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19, or who has travelled outside of Ontario in the last 14 days cannot enter.

A change in race surface, race distance, track condition or jockey.

A wrong ticket (even after you have left the mutuel window).

A scratch of part of an entry.

Where can you cancel tickets?

Tickets purchased at a Self Serve terminal or via Mutuel Tellers may be Canceled at any Mutuel Teller if the ticket was purchased at Fort Erie Race Track

For tickets valued at \$300.00 or more, you must Print your name (first and surname) and phone number clearly on the back of the ticket (before presenting to the Mutuel Teller) Present government-issued identification to the Mutuel Teller

WIN 4, PICK 3 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Win4, Rolling Pick 3 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 or Pick 5, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection. However, if scratch occurs in any leg of the Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 & Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by the Canadian Department of Agriculture and Agri-Food ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 years shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim that a wrong ticket has been issued must be made before the customer leaves the teller's window. A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty-four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher. No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the payout prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. Notice boards and Photo Finish display boards are located in the Clubhouse, in addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. "Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING INCLUDING LATE DAILY DOUBLE

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double. The Daily Double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the Daily Double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has been declared official, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool.

EXACTOR BETTING

An Exactor bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish in the race on which the pool is operated. If the same betting interest finishes first and second (i.e., 1-1, 2-2) the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

TRIACTOR BETTING

A Triactor bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish in the race on which the pool is operated.

SUPERFECTA WAGERING

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish in the race on which the pool is operated.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a SINGLE winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

WIN 4, ROLLING PICK 3 AND PICK 5 BETTING

The Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 and PICK 5 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of four, three or five successive races specified for the Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 or PICK 5 respectively. Winning tickets for the Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 and a mandatory payout of the PICK 5 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs; B) most winners; then refund. If there is a surface change in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners on any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

WIN 4, ROLLING PICK 3, AND PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Win4, Rolling Pick 3 or PICK 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Win 4, Rolling Pick 3 or PICK 5, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection. However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Rolling Pick 3 or Win 4 & PICK 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, track announcer, etc. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick 3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick 4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least on horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

Subject to the Regulations, in the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure, various courses of action may result depending on the nature of the breakdown. Bets from the affected sites, including advance bets, may be considered as a separate pool or may even be refunded in the event of a complete system failure. Changing a site's bets from common pool to separate pool may affect the odds and prices. Where possible, customers will be advised of the course of action taken.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

"Lost Tickets" originally sold at Fort Erie Race Track please inquire at the Mutuel office at Fort Erie. Tickets or Vouchers issued at Fort Erie Race Track are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from the date of purchase. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address to Mutuel Manager, P.O. BOX 1130, Fort Erie, Ontario, L2A 5N9, keeping a photocopy for future reference. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

Fort Erie Race Track and other simulcast associations in Ontario deduct and retain the following percentages from wagers placed at their own licensed sites which are then shared between horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

FORT ERIE LIVE Win, Place, Show wagers: 13.65% WIN 4 wagers: 14 % Jackpot Hi-5: 11.7% 22.9% all other wagers

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except 4% on trifecta wagering, for the horse improvement program.

The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all wagers placed in Ontario.

The Canadian Government through a revolving fund cost recovery basis retains 0.8% on all bets placed in Canada for provision of drug control; photo-finish, video patrol and audit services.
