Race 3 - #2 "Wicken Cents" was unruly arriving to the paddock and scratched by the official Veterinarian. Stewards Inquiry into the start regarding #5 "Only Believe" ridden by Ismael Mosquera, reared when the doors opened and unseated the rider. The horse was deemed to

have received a fair start. Received a call from EMS who advised that Mr. Mosquiera does not have a concussion but is sore and suggests he not be allowed to ride the rest of the card. We have advised the Clerk of Scales he is off the rest of his mounts.
