Key Race of the Day – Race 4 – LongRun Thoroughbred Aftercare Stakes – 5 1/2 Furlongs

The LongRun Thoroughbred Aftercare Stakes kicks off the late pick five and features a field of five. **#1 Soupergirl** looks extremely tough to beat off her first start at the Fort – she whistled out of the gate and rattled off swift fractions to win by three-quarters of a length. Once again, she appears to be the main speed and could steal this on the front end while just making her third start of 2026. The runner up in that race, **#2 Empty Gesture**, is back to take another crack at Soupergirl and she could certainly take a big step forward. She is also just making her third start this year and she enters this race off her career best Beyer of a 73. Juan Crawford sticks with her here and is drawn alongside the speedy favorite, which may allow the pair to keep their sights on the target while saving some ground. On paper, she appears to be the one that is most likely to defeat Soupergirl. **#4 Get Out the Vote** has won for fun in her two races here this season – she took a \$6.25k claiming event by seven and a half lengths on opening day and most recently won a starter optional claiming event by four. In her first start of the year, she made the lead early and stayed in front, but against tougher last time out, she found herself rating the pacesetters early and still was much the best. Steve Jadoo will have options with this mare, which is always a plus.
