Key Race of the Day – Race 2 – Allowance – 1 Mile 70 Yards

Tuesday's pick five sequence gets underway in race two and while it's not a huge field, this field is competitive and it looks as though the pace will be key. **#5 In You Insist** has been a very fun horse to watch here on the main track – he's yet to finish worse than second in eight starts at the Fort and those races have been at a variety of distances. With that said, he's a forward type, but doesn't need the lead to win and today, he'll break from the outside, which figures to work nicely since the other speed draws the rail and hasn't won routing since 2024. As long as he doesn't duel with the other speed, he should be right there at the wire. Now, the other speed, **#1 Baxley** is a major threat – he's been in some tough spots this year and will route for the first time since March 3rd, when he was second at Mahoning Valley. Most of his work has been sprinting, but he did win in 2024 at today's distance at Prairie Meadows. He figures to impact the tempo and sometimes we see horses get bold on the lead, even when stretching out. Also, it's worth noting with the wet weather in the forecast, an offtrack should be just fine for him. With forward types on the bookends of the starting gate, **#3 Scat Factor** could potentially trip out in here – this gelding loves going two-turns and won a pair of events here last fall. This will be just his third start of the year, and second on the dirt. Sometimes he's been far back, other times he's stalked and if he ends up being somewhat close to fractions a tad on the fast side, he should be able to pass rivals late. If the fractions are very quick early, watch out.
