Backstretch:

Jockey Kirk Johnson issued a two-day riding suspension, to be served October 5 and 6, 2026, TB Ruling #3911199.

Official Veterinarians Dr. Matt Nugent and Dr. Stephanie Campbell-Heron on duty today.

Race 1, September 21, 2026. Jockeys Pierre Mailhot, Juan Crawford and JBAC Daren Gomez. Pierre Mailhot assessed a two-day riding suspension. Days to be determined.

Race 1, All clear

Race 2, on advisement of the Official Veterinarian, #1 Abitibi was scratched after warming up, refund of \$7,158. Reviewed run down the backstretch, #2 Legs Like Flatter, J. Crawford, 1st, did jump a shadow when in full flight on the inside, prevailed, rest ok

Race 3, Turf, #1 Harper City, S. Vives, 5th, off a step slow, rest ok.
Following the 3rd race Jockey Brian Cheyne was excused from his mount in the 5th race.

Race 4, #6 Glintindaddyseye, S. Vives, bore out at start, prevailed, rest ok

Race 5, #6 Speedy Lady, L. Contreras, 5th, slight stumble at start, #3 Midnite Sadie, E. Ramsammy, 7th, off a step slow, rest ok

Race 6, Turf, Jockey claim of foul #1 C. Douglas 5th on #3 L. Contreras, 2nd, inside 1/8 mile marker, upon review of back tower and upper pan, #1 inside is bouncing around and comes out a couple of times to the #3, it was determined the two were equally responsible for the alleged interference and the claim of foul disallowed,

Stewards' Inquiry stretch run regarding #4, K. Johnson and #7 P. Mailhot, upon review of front tower and upper pan camera angles, #4 ducks out into the path of #7, #7 catches a heel and stumbles slightly, #4 finished 3rd and subsequently placed 7th.
